The front page of the paper should provide details of author's name, affiliation/organization, email address and telephone number. All tables and figures should be numbered and should appear in the corresponding text with captions. Source should be explicitly mentioned at the bottom of the table/figure. The superscript numeral used to refer to a footnote must appear in the text.

Footnote should appear at the bottom of the normal text area. APA Citation style must be followed for references. All correspondence will be addressed to the first author only.
