The President of the function, Chancellor CA. A. Raghavendra Rao stressed on students getting transformed into an employable graduate through active participation at such career events.




The Pro-Chancellor of Srinivas University Dr. A. Srinivas Rao expressed his happiness on creation of avenues for employability in the society.
