


### 2. DRUG-FREE MANGALORE CITY





#### 9. Institute of Social Sciences and Humanities celebrates International Women's Day






#### 10. Workshop on preparation for exam













### 14. Essay Writing Competition @ D.K.Z.P.H.P School, Malar and Pavoor-2022
