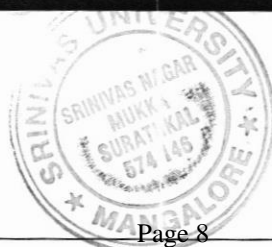
7.Prevention of sexual harassment at work place 26-04-2022

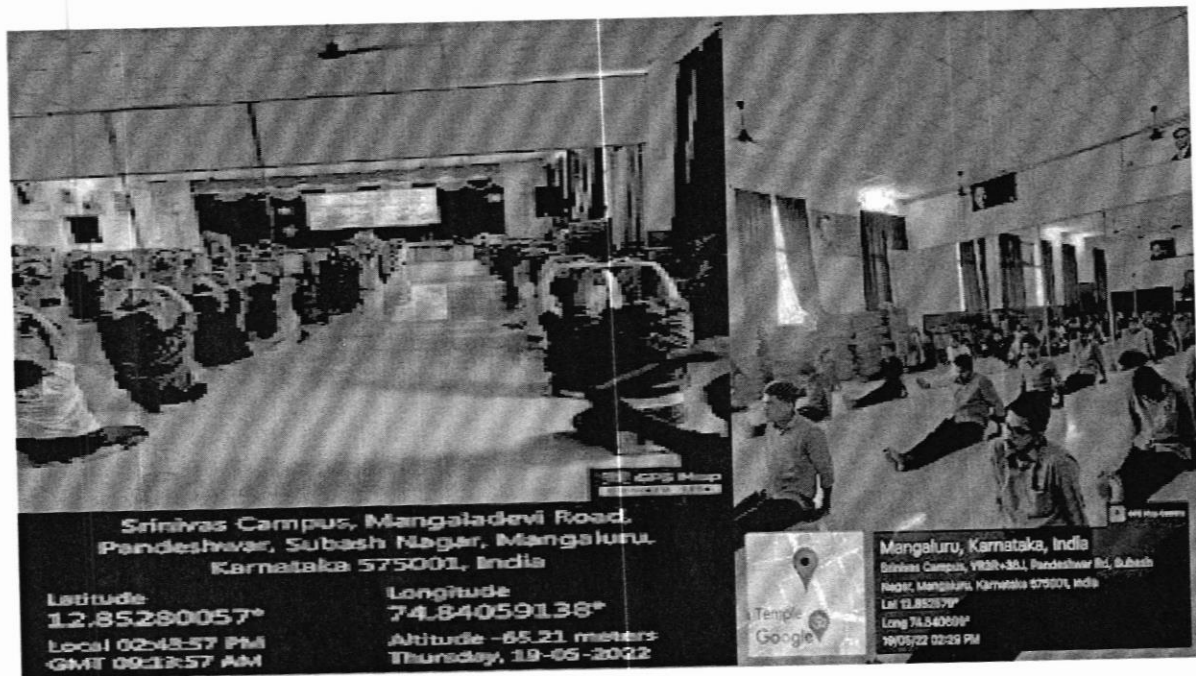

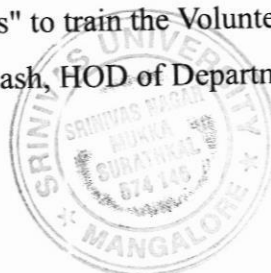
8 Yoga Training Programme 19-05-22

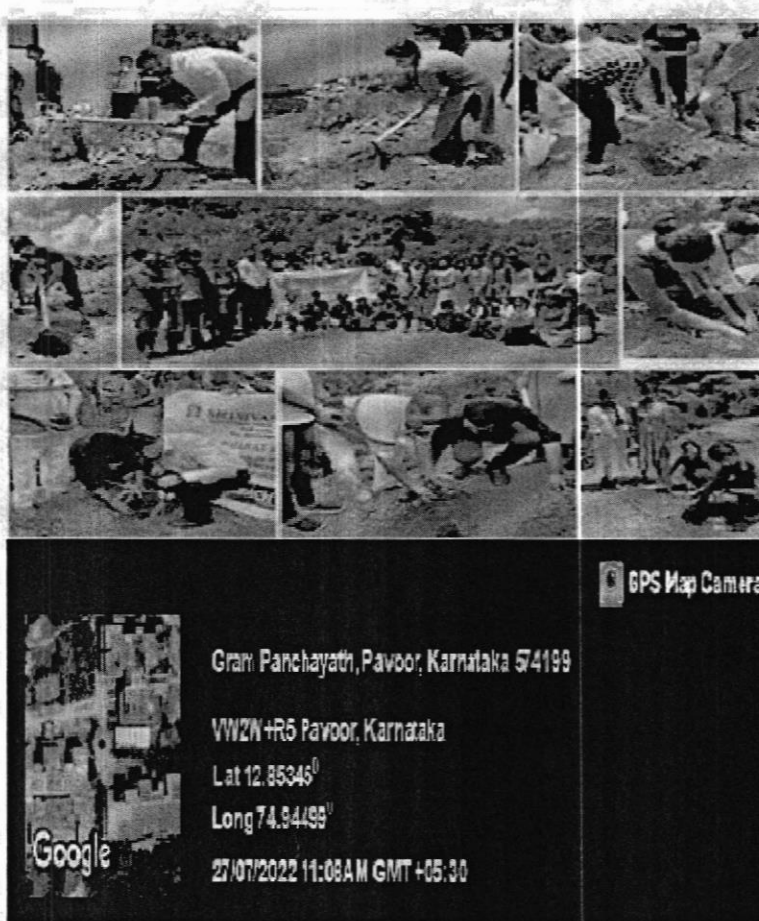
15 Plantation Programme

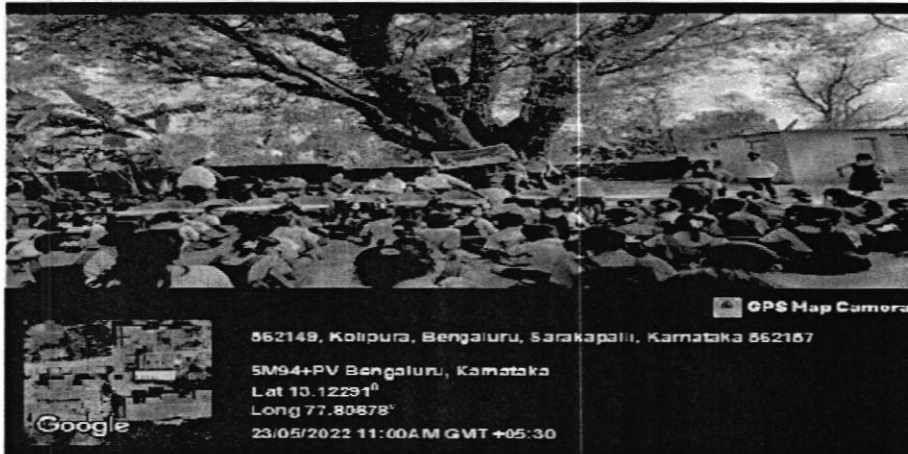
23. Awareness of Environmental Hygiene the college of education organised the program on 23rd May 2022

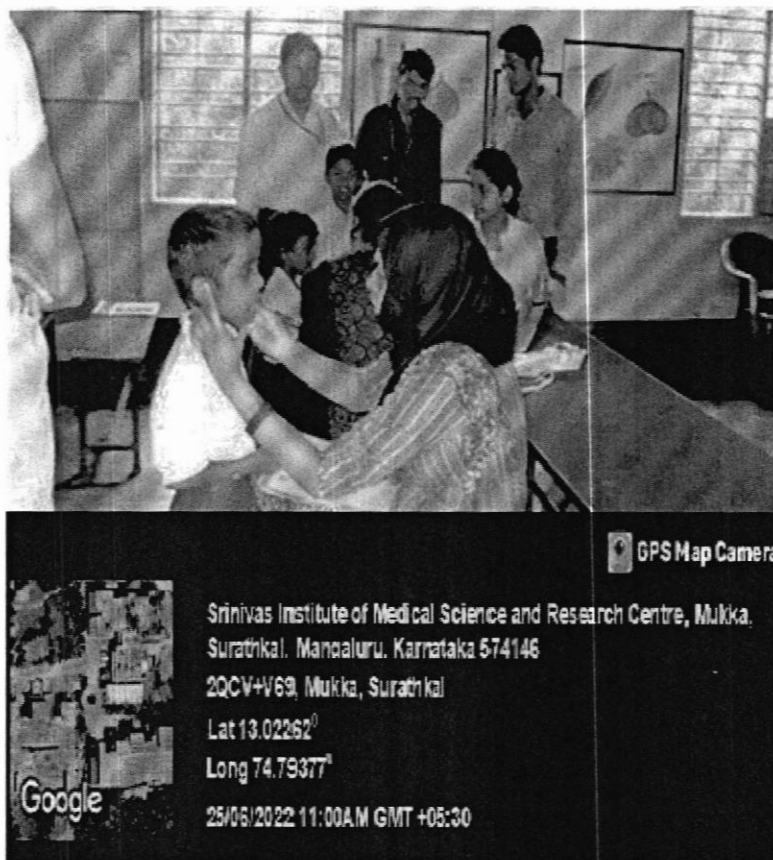
The free medical camps organized by Srinivas University on 25/06/2022 received overwhelming participation from individuals in the target communities, including men, women, children, and

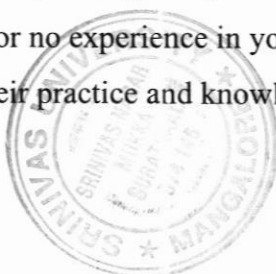

29 Yoga and Meditation camps

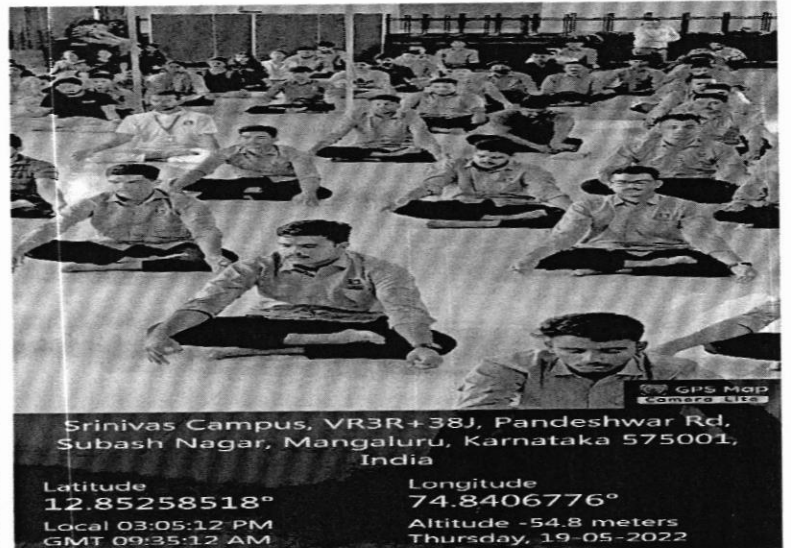
