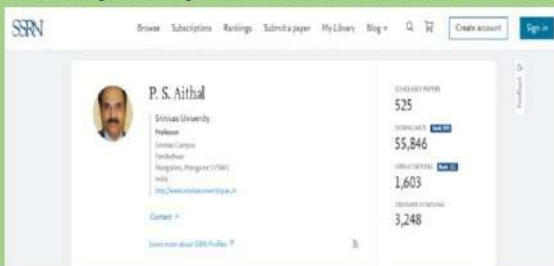
The ninth year of its existence is being celebrated with a difference due to the continued challenge of COVID-19 by organizing student-centered, faculty-focused activities both in research and skill

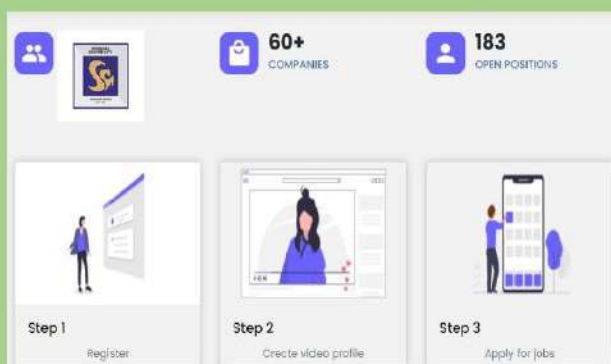

E LECTURE ON FILM SCRIPTING

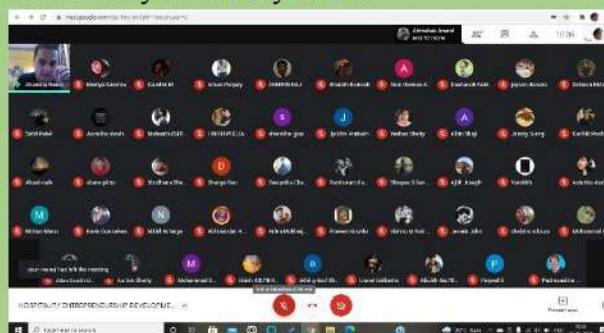
