UNIVERSITY POLICY ON INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIP AND FREE SHIPS

University has actively undertaken numerous scholarships such as Institutional Scholarship, Scholarships for Karnataka Students, Chancellors Special Merit Scholarships, Chancellors Research Scholarship, Scholarship for Staff to Pursue Higher Education, Fellowship/Teaching Assistance, Post-Doctoral Fellowship, Fees Relaxation for the students belonging to weaker section and Scholarship for Children's of the Parents who are the employees of Srinivas University. This policy documents provides clear cut guidelines on various criteria and conditions requirement by the students to avail the before mentioned scholarships.

I. INSTITUTIONAL SCHOLARSHIP:

Merit Scholarships for Karnataka Students: Up to 30% waiver in fee for Karnataka Students in all courses of Srinivas University except of Para-Medical program. The above scholarship is extended to all the undergraduate students of "Gadinadu Kannadiga".

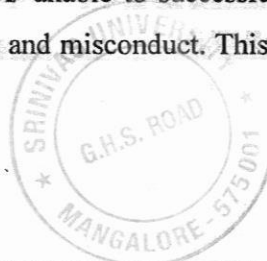
II. CHANCELLORS MERIT SCHOLARSHIP:

The scholarships will be announced through Admission Notifications, which are distributed to the public at various times throughout the year.

- 1) 100 % Tuition fee waiver for one student in each program who has scored more than 95% in previous program.
- 2) 50% Tuition fee waiver for 5 students in each program who has scored more than 90% in previous program.

Note: Students eligible for above mentioned clause can continue availing the scholarship if they continue to score above 7.5 CGPA. But the students will not be eligible to continue this scholarship if the student has scored below 7.5 CGPA/ unable to successfully complete all exams on the first attempt/ engaged in unfair practices and misconduct. This Scholarship not applicable Para-Medical Courses.

III. CHANCELLORS SPECIAL SCHOLARSHIPS:

1. Chancellor Research Scholarship: To encourage research focus up to 75% Waiver for Full-Time/Part Time Ph.D. scholars is provided.
2. Chancellors Merit Scholarship for Teachers Children: Up to 100 % Waiver on Tuition Fee.
3. The candidate who are pursuing Ph.D. in Sanskrit will be eligible for a scholarship of Rs. 1,00,000.

VI. SCHOLARSHIP FOR STAFF TO PURSUE HIGHER EDUCATION:

1. Evening College Post Graduate Student Scholarship: Up to 50% Waiver on Tuition Fee.
2. Part-Time Ph.D. Scholarship: The faculty member of Srinivas University who are pursuing their Ph.D. will avail the scholarship up to 75% of Annual Fee.
3. Employees of Srinivas University with Ph.D. will be given 100 % Fee waiver for PDF Program.

V. FELLOWSHIP/TEACHING ASSISTANCE:

1. Full-time Ph.D. Research fellows in selected subjects (such as Management, Commerce, Computer Science & Information Science, Engineering & Technology, and Allied Health Sciences) are offered teaching assistance ship.
 - a. Rs. 10,000 per month up to 3 Years as teaching assistantship.

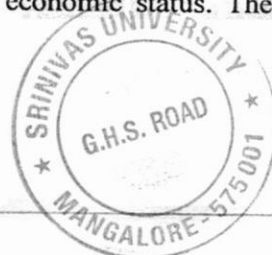
VI. POST-DOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP:

1. Full-time Postdoctoral Research Fellows with a Ph.D. in recognized subjects (Business Management) from recognized Indian or foreign universities are permitted to work as associate faculty and are offered a monthly stipend of up to 30,000 for a maximum of two years.

VII. FINANCIAL & OTHER ASSISTANCE/ FEES RELAXATION FOR THE STUDENTS BELONGING TO WEAKER SECTION:

The financial aid is disbursed to meritorious and weaker section specially SC/ST and the students OBC category. Various stream of students benefited from various scholarship from government, Institutional and NGOs based on merit and economic status. The university

extends total co-operation and support to the students belonging to SC/ST, OBC and economically weaker sections category. They are made aware of the different types of schemes that are available to students from the Social Welfare Department, Minority department both State as well Central Government. The information about the same is made aware to the students & also special care is taken that it reaches to the students. For the assistance of various scholarships, university has formed information and empowerment centre cell.

Students from economically weaker sections will get following support services:

1. The university permit flexible timeframe to remit the college fee by assessing the need and genuineness on a case-to-case basis which will support the economically weaker students to stick to their studies without drop-out.
2. The university has MOU with several national banks to provide educational loan to its students so that they get education loan to continue in the course without drop-out.
3. Many students from economically weaker sections fail to adjust to the new situation around them when they come to the city and start living here. The college extends counselling facility and provides hostel facility especially for such students. Transportation is provided in such cases by the college through a fleet of Buses.
4. The university has an innovative program of 'EARN WHILE LEARN'. Students are encouraged to take-up part time jobs which are available plenty in the city, which would make them self-dependent and encourages the continuation of studies.
