

## Report on Fresher's Day





R & D activities.






## Voice of Young India

Students learned through experiential learning and the feedback was good, many rated in excellent in terms of their




Conclusion: This program brought together all students and faculty members. The micro learning has been good and they came back and shared their experiences with other students of the university.


