These may include disciplinary knowledge, critical thinking skills, communication abilities, problem-solving capabilities, and interpersonal skills.Competency-based education emphasizes clearly defined learning outcomes or competencies that students are expected to achieve by the end of a program or course. These outcomes are typically aligned with industry standards, professional requirements, or disciplinary frameworks.Unlike traditional education models with fixed timelines and course sequences, competency-based education offers flexible pathways for students to progress at their own pace. Students advance as they demonstrate mastery of competencies through assessments, rather than advancing based on time spent in the classroom.Competency-based education often incorporates personalized learning approaches, allowing students to engage with course materials in ways that suit their individual learning styles, preferences, and interests. This may include self-paced learning modules, adaptive technologies, and tailored support services.Assessment in competency-based education focuses on evaluating students' mastery of specific competencies rather than their performance on standardized tests or grades in individual courses. Assessment methods may include project-based assessments, portfolios, performance evaluations, and competency exams.
