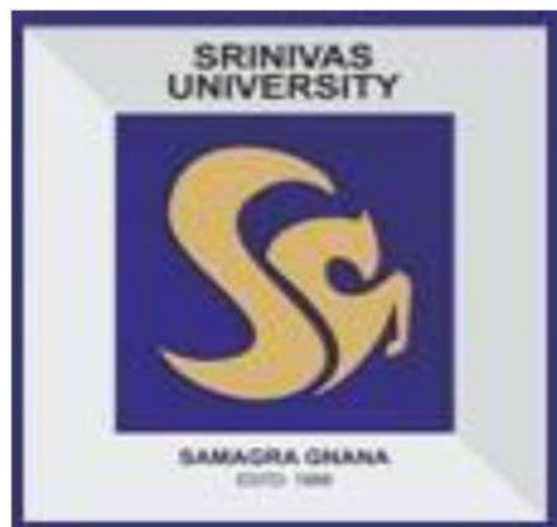
5. DENTAL & ORAL HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME
