To cater to the rising air traffic, the Government of India has been working to increase the number of airports. As of March 2019, India had 103 operational airports.


## NATIONAL VIRTUAL CONFERENCE




## National Level Virtual Conference on "Future Technologies of IT, Management, Education and Social Sciences"

"A literature review paper is equivalent to a hundred scholarly papers as it summarizes the findings of many research articles. When selecting a research paper for review the author must download the source from standard journals.

# Technical Talk on "Research and Publication Ethics"

In his session, he explained the important aspects of research, researcher-supervisor relationship and the ethics to be followed when publishing the research articles. "PhD is the foundation for a long research career. Research should be a passion not an option. Researcher should be dare enough to think differently. One cannot write the entire paper without referring the research articles but should contribute a small original thought. Researcher and the supervisor have to travel a long way together so one need to maintain a good relationship with the supervisor. Researcher should maintain physical, mental and emotional fitness throughout the research career. Yoga, meditation and regular exercises help the researcher to overcome the stress. When writing research articles, the researcher should avoid copy-paste operation. For easy reading researcher should refer white-papers." he said.


