### **Training and Placements**

Srinivas University – Institute of Engineering and Technology (SUIET) has been in the forefront of activities bringing both corporate and companies close to the campus and encouraging them to establish facilities to cater to the needs of both faculty and students.

The Department of Training and Placement takes initiative to provide adequate training to students to enable them to have better employability skills.

Employability Skill Enhancement Program (ESEP) is introduced in the curriculum from 2nd year to cater the needs of the industry and prepare the students accordingly. Weekly assessments are conducted through Naxeed Portal, wherein the assessments are curated by Industry experts.

The Department is actively involved in hosting Industry- Academia Connect Programs to benefit the students and faculties.

The placement department arranges campus interviews from various national and multi-national companies for campus recruitment and also helps various Head of Departments in placing the students for Internships and project work at industries and other research & development organizations. The Institute has an impressive track record of both placements and participating Companies. Besides this, the placement cell organizes mock interviews, personality development Programs, seminars, group discussions, invited talks of prospective employers.

The **NEP** is based on four pillars which are Access, Equity, Quality, and Accountability. Through this, the government is looking forward to making India a "global knowledge superpower" and it will be only done by making education system more flexible, holistic, and multi-disciplinary which will bring out their unique capabilities. We have implemented certain features of the same. The curriculum in all subjects has been reduced to its core essentials, and academic credits earned by students will be counted for the final degree. Through this, they focus on critical thinking, discovery, inquiry, discussion, and teaching based on analysis and holistic learning methods for education. Focus on E-learning so that they can reduce their dependency on textbook etc. All this will enable our students to get global standards in India.

The **Srinivas Innovation & Incubation Center (SIIC)** was set up in the campus to give wings to the nascent ideas of the students and designed to nurture and grow new and small businesses by supporting them through early stages of development and change.



A State of the art Aircraft Hangar of modern dimensions and proportions was established to house the 3 aircraft and the simulator along with laboratory equipment of the Aircraft Maintenance Engineering department.



The institute has 52 faculty members on its rolls which comprise of 42 regular, 5 R&D, 4 Part time and 1 DST staff. 15 of them have PhD's and majority of them have enrolled for their PhD.

### **Library**

The Library is housed in an Area of 1730 sq. mtrs & Reading Area of 736 sq. mtrs with a seating capacity of 75. It uses Easylib Library Automation Software. 752 students have registered with NDL and total library members is 920+. The Library subscribes to several daily newspapers.

The Number of Volumes available is 25808 with 4851 Titles, 1510 E-Books, 1,327 CD's with Bound Volumes, Study Materials, Internship Reports, Project Reports, Thesis etc. The total amount spent for books is Rs. 68,43,418.00

Every department maintains their own departmental library which has a total of more than 1,200 books. The library is also provided with e-library, digital library and Book bank facilities for the benefit of the students.

• The institute has fully furnished laboratories, workshops, state-of-the-art computer centers with high end computers and networking, and a separate section for CAED to teach Computer Aided Drawing, which is upgraded every year.

• The campus has Free Internet Facility with 500 Mbps (1:1) leased line internet connection and also provides Wi-Fi facility to the students & Staff.

• Every Department has full-fledged laboratories having the latest equipment.




### CONFERENCE




Figure 2: Faculty in Srinivas University




Figure 3: Discipline wise Faculty in Srinivas University




Figure 4: Undergraduate Admissions 2019-20




Fig5: Undergraduate Admissions Breakup




Figure 6: Masters Admissions Breakup




Figure 7: Research Admissions Breakup

#### Library and Information Centre

Realizing the importance of Library in teaching the foundation has concentrated on building a modern library which has more than 65000 volumes covering all branches of Engineering, Management, Medicine, Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Nursing and Pharmacy. The library is also e-enabled and has adopted open access system and maintains OPAC to access the stack. The library subscribes to both hard volumes as well as e-journal in the respective disciplines and has created a vast reservoir of information to be accessed by the faculty, staff, students and researchers.

#### Services and Amenities at the Campus:

#### **Centralized Library**

Srinivas Group provides students with spacious library with more than 22000 books in 1200 different titles. Separate libraries for Management Books and Computer Science

Books have been developed which are centrally controlled. The Library is under the process of digitalization and is expected to be complete in a few months. The Library subscribes over 100Management Journals/Magazines and 50 Computer Science Journals/Magazines along with over 60 general reading magazines and newspapers.





#### **Modern Computer Lab**
