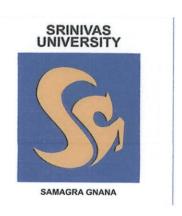

#### 1. Introduction

The Examination Department of Srinivas University is governed by the University Regulation and Examinations Manual, which are in line with the vision and mission of the University.

For offering high quality examination services, the Examination department of Srinivas University ensures transparency in all its activities, aimed to support faculty, students, and institutions. The Department administers open and secured processes and systems and work in close collaboration with institutions, external organizations, and individuals.

Examination department is headed by the Registrar (Evaluation). The entire process of assessment and evaluation including the conduct of examination is as per the provisions of the University regulation and Examination Manual. As per the policy of the University, the continuous and final evaluation system is adopted to evaluate the learner's ability to develop analytical skills and decision making power.

The Department is having overall responsibility for end to end process of the student's assessment by preparing question paper, conducting Final Examinations, valuation of answer scripts and declaration of Results etc.

The first purpose of assessment is to determine whether students have achieved the learning outcomes and fulfilled the academic requirements of the course and modules within it, and attained the standard required for the award of grade.

# 2. Question Paper preparation and valuation Process

University Examination department prepares the list of question paper setter as per the list provided by the BOE Chairman of each programme based on their experience in the subjects taught. For each subject / course, 2 question paper setters are identified who will be preparing 3 question papers (2+1). Once all the question papers are drafted, the same will be submitted to the BOE Chairman who will be scrutinizing the question paper to review the quality of question paper, and will be doing the corrections if any. After the approval from the BOE Chairman, the approved question papers are forwarded to the University Examination Department for further proceedings.

The Chief Coordinator will organize the coding of answer books in a strictly confidential manner. There shall be double valuation for theory papers in the University Examinations. The highest marks of the two valuations shall be considered as the marks secured by the candidate. The Chief Coordinator shall ensure that the decoding has been done correctly and there shall not be any



discrepancies.

#### 3. Examination Schedule

The students register themselves according to their regular and back-log courses and the examinations are conducted only based on registered subject codes. The Examination department prepares the Examination Schedule and publishes the same on the website for students. A copy of the Schedule is sent to the Dean of institutes for information to the students and to the competent authorities for their information. The Notification of Exams is prepared as per the dates mentioned in Academic Calendar.
