COLLEGE GENERAL RULES

The rules and regulations of the college are framed by the management to ensure a peaceful campus atmosphere as well as to inculcate a good practice among student community. All the students should adhere to following guidelines

- 1. Every student shall attend classes regularly.
- 2. Students shall dress neatly and decently.
- 3. Students shall always behave with dignity and courtesy.
- 4. Students shall desist from damaging the college building, disfiguring the walls, furniture etc. by writing or sticking bills. Such actions are offensive to good taste and are a positive disservice to succeeding generations of students. The cost of the damage, if any, will be recovered.
- 5. No student shall leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher or until the teacher has left the classroom. Students coming late shall enter the class only with the permission of the teacher.
- 6. Irregular attendance, insubordination to teachers, habitual shirking of class work, obscenity of any sort are sufficient grounds for the suspension or the dismissal of a student from the college.
- 7. Smoking and using or keeping alcoholic drinks or drugs are strictly forbidden inside and outside the college campus.
- 8. No student shall indulge in any activity which may cause disruption to classes or disturbances in the college campus. If any student violates the above regulation, he/she is liable to be dismissed from the college summarily.
- 9. Ragging, teasing, intimidating, harassing, using words of abuse etc. on junior students within the campus or outside is a punishable crime under police act and such matters will be immediately reported to the police. Students involved in such acts will be terminated.
- 10. The identity card must be with the students whenever he/she is in the College Campus
- 11. The minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of working days required for the annual certificate is absolutely essential for promotion and for admission to the University examination.
- 12. Students shall be polite and decent in their words and deeds and shall preserve order and decorum. They must be courteous both inside the campus as also outside. They are reminded to work for the common good.
- 13. Students must take pride in keeping the college and its environs clean and beautiful.
- 14. Students should clear all the dues if any pending, before attending the class/lab.
- 15. Defaming the institution or its faculty is strictly prohibited. If found guilty, students may face termination, depending on the severity of the content.
