## NATIONAL CONFERENCE ON RECENT TRENDS IN CIVIL ENGINEERING

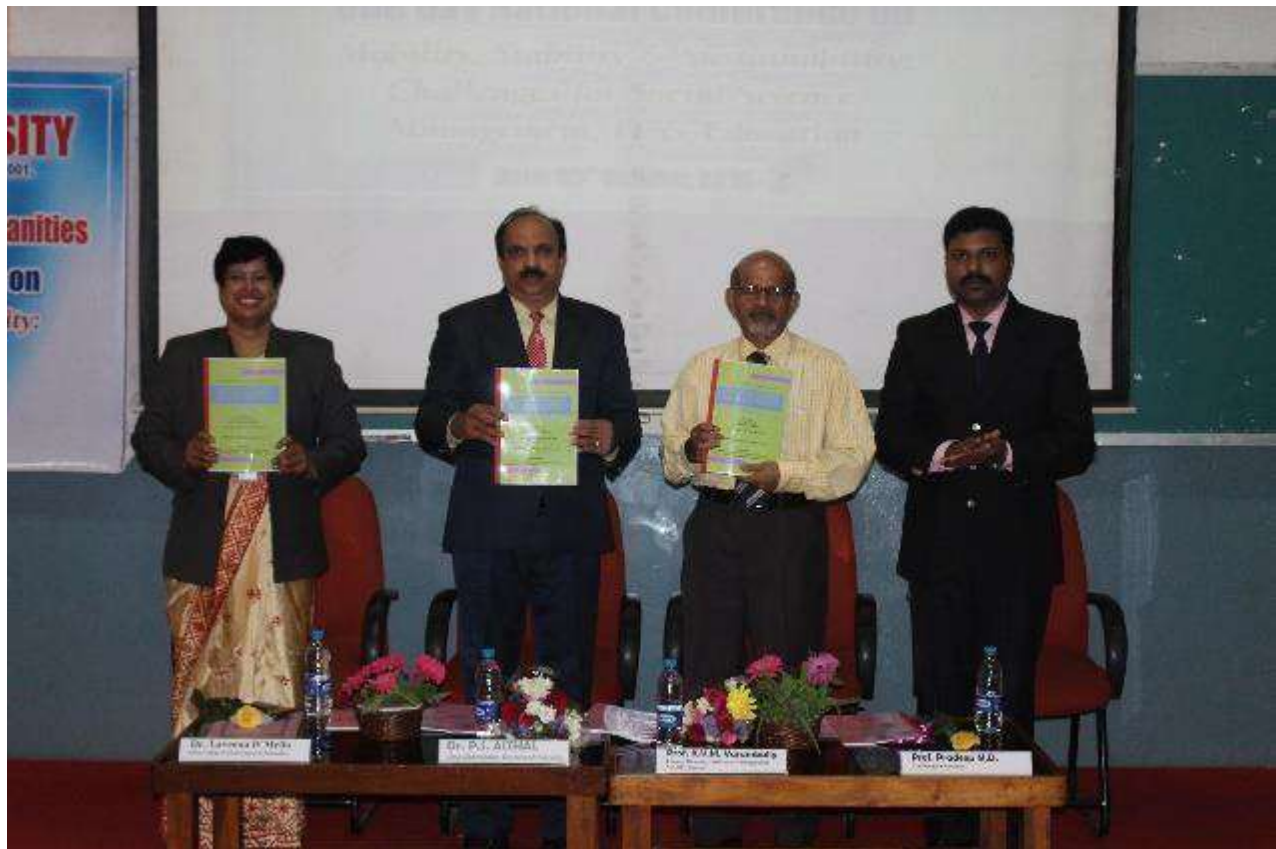
